The Safety Training programme on ATEX (Explosive Atmosphere) has been fully revised to better meet the needs of the Organization. It is being progressively introduced on <u>CERN's Learning Hub</u> under the Safety/Chemical Safety (C) catalogue.

The updated programme has been defined in collaboration with specialists from the HSE-OHS group and EP Safety Office. It aims to ensure that personnel working near or inside ATEX Zones, or directly intervening on ATEX equipment, receive the appropriate training based on the level of risk, and their activity and/or role.
